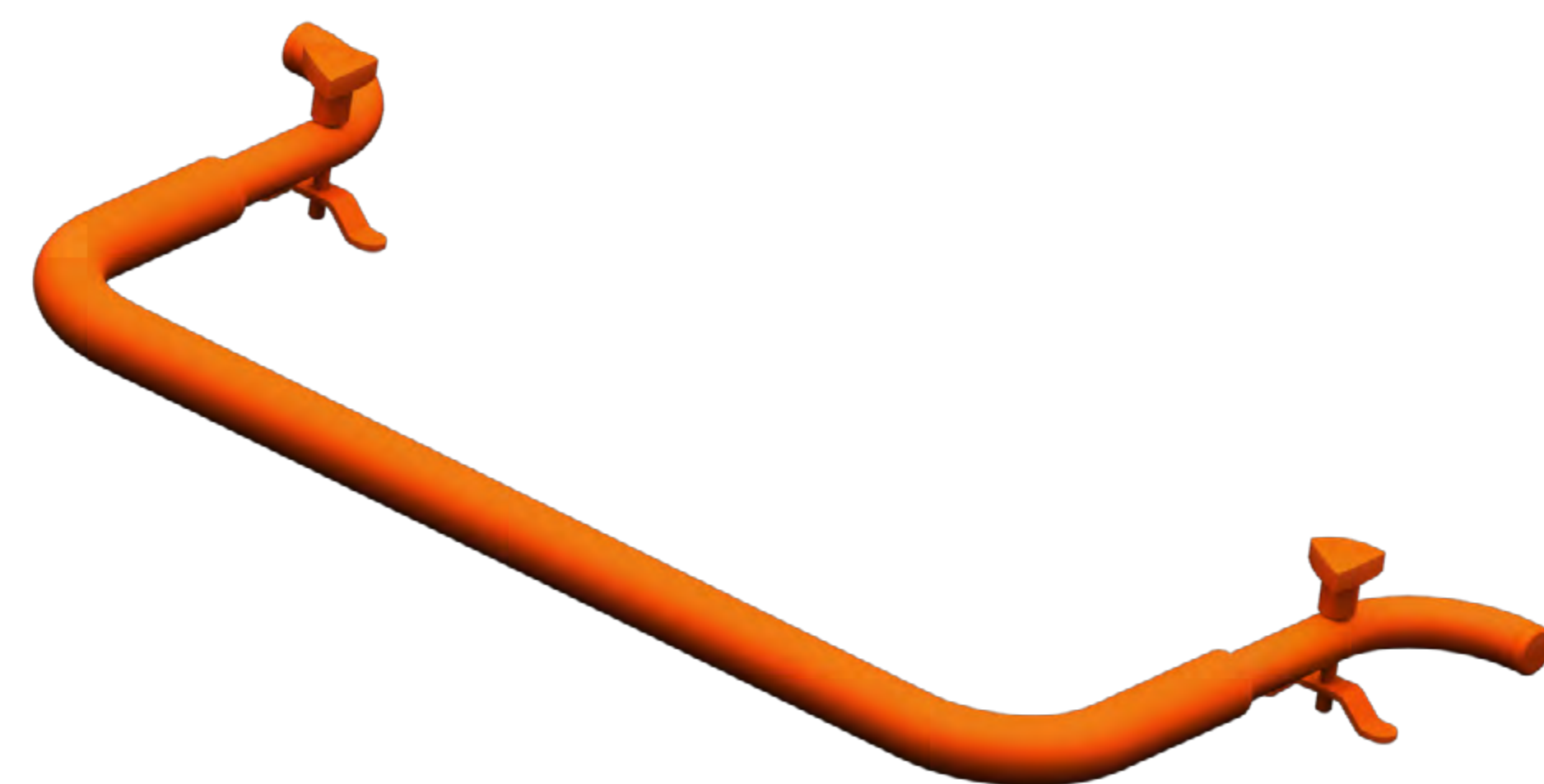

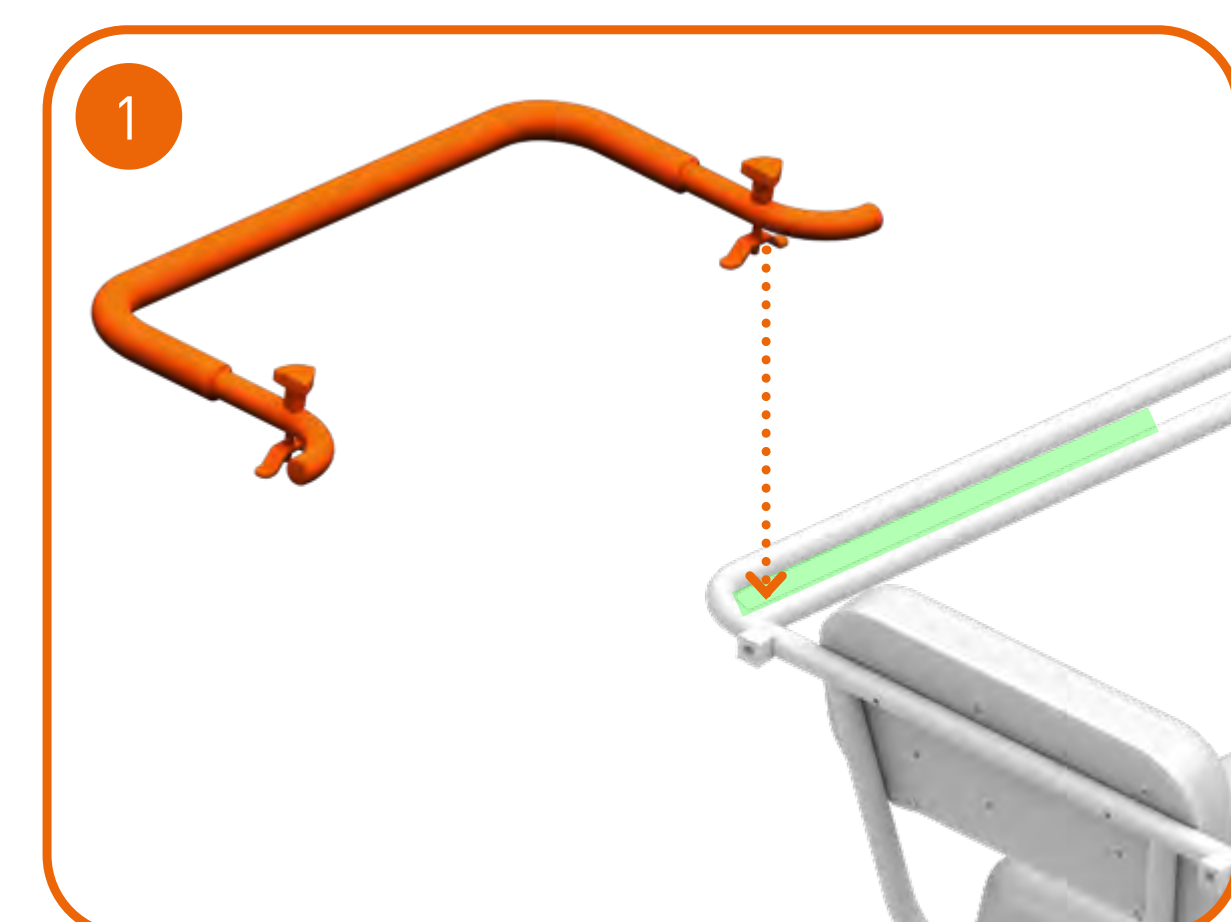
These instructions show how to assemble and use the VELO DE VILLE BICYCLE HOOK on the VELO DE VILLE LOADY.

The VELO DE VILLE BICYCLE HOOK can only be used with the VELO DE VILLE Ride Bar!

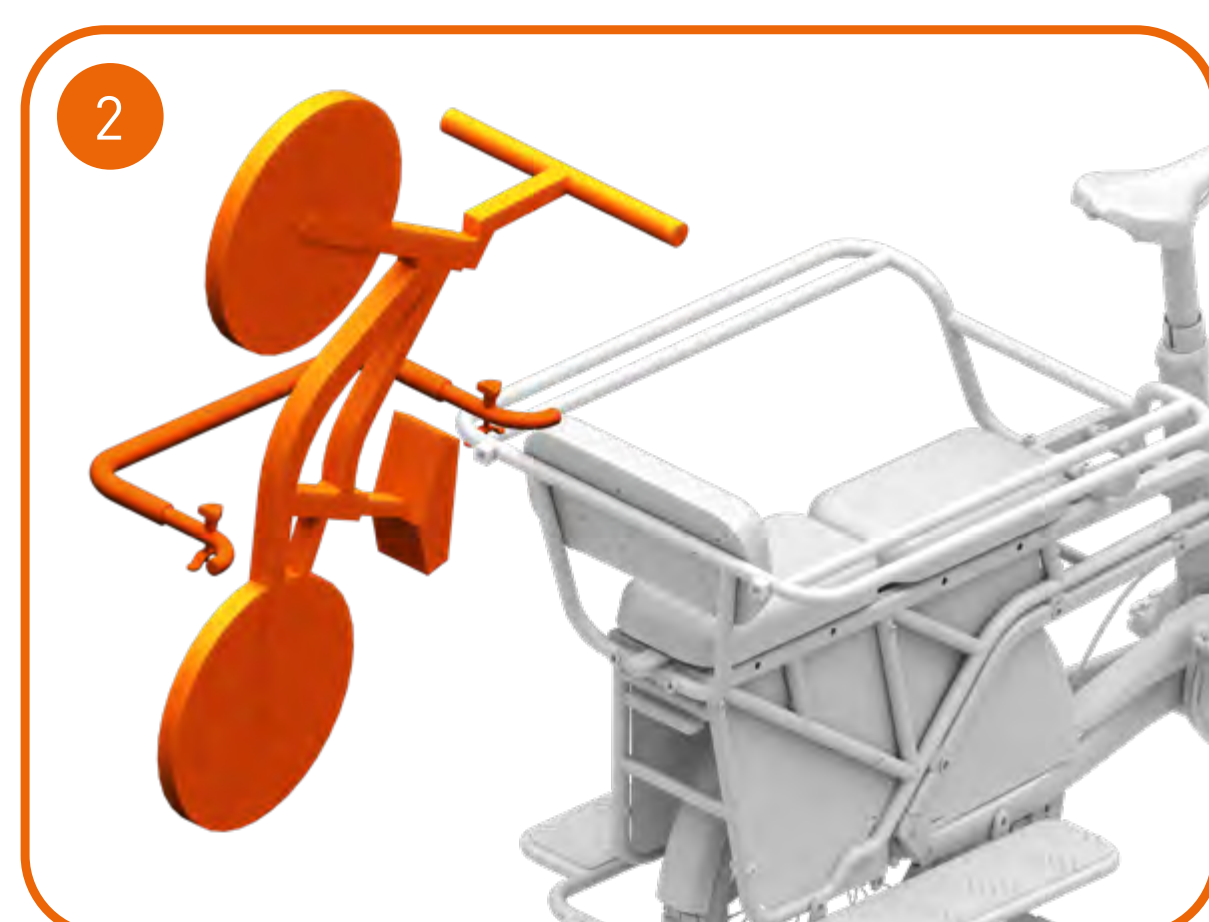
The VELO DE VILLE BICYCLE HOOK is approved for children's bikes and balance bikes with wheel sizes up to 16" and a maximum weight of 10 kg!



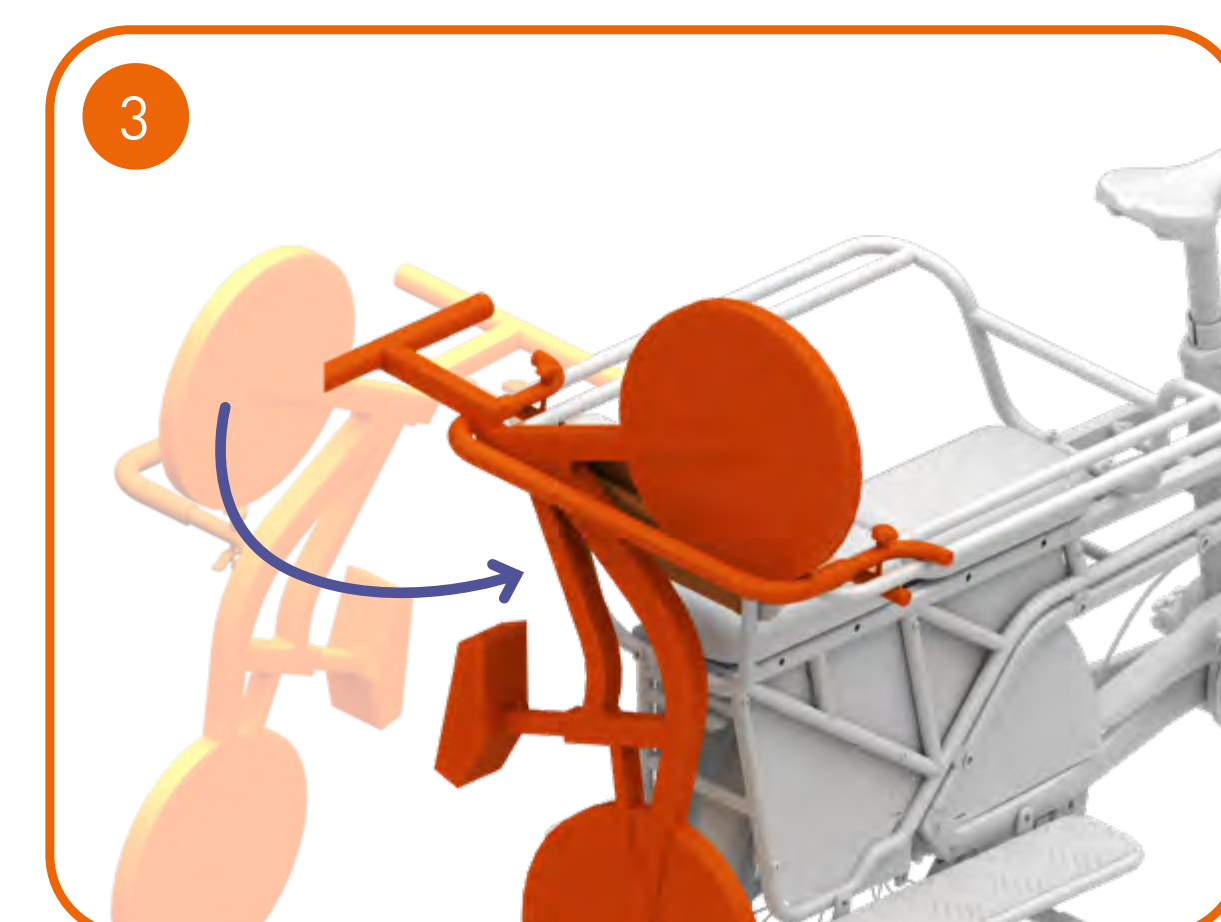
1x BICYCLE HOOK

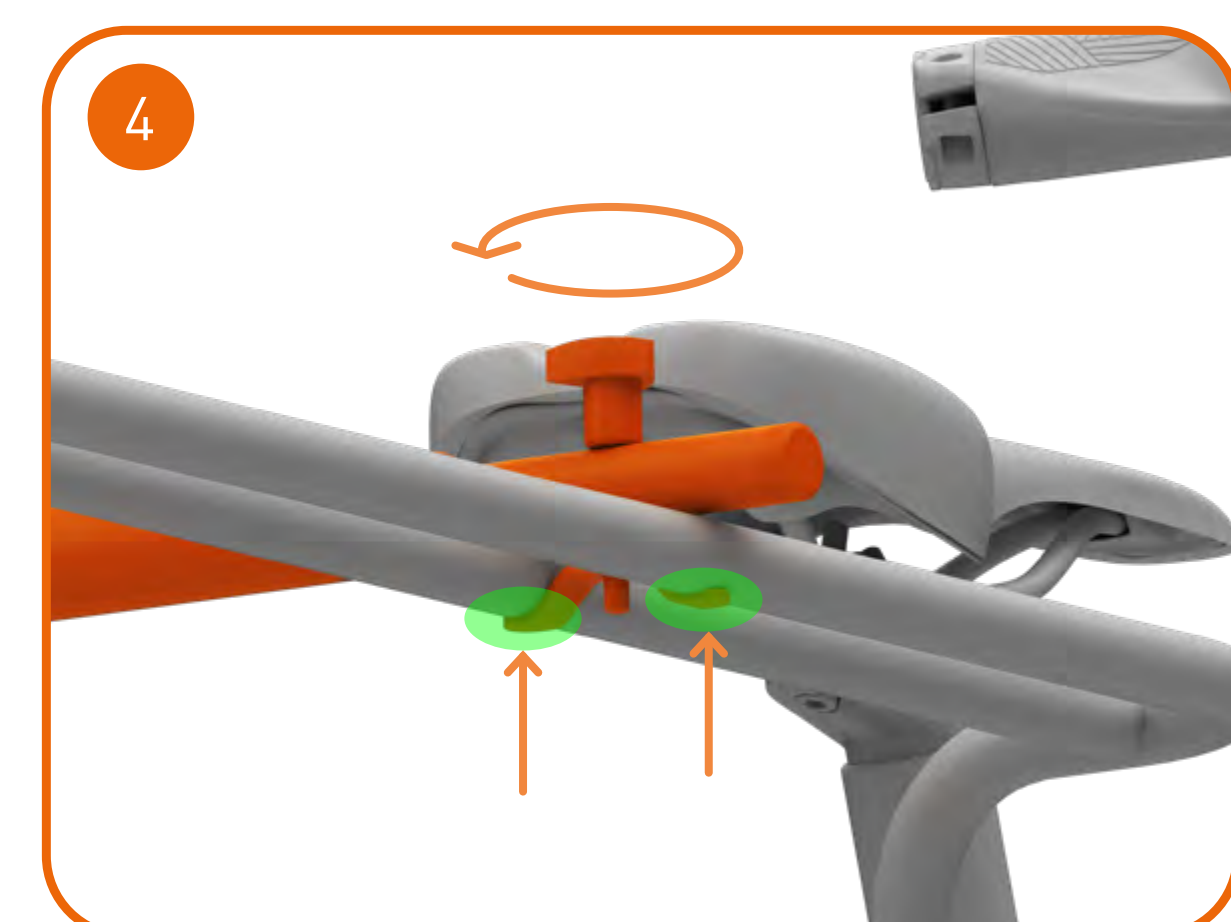
Position the pre-assembled BICYCLE HOOK on the Ride Bar. Ensure that the clamps are positioned **between the outer and inner struts**.



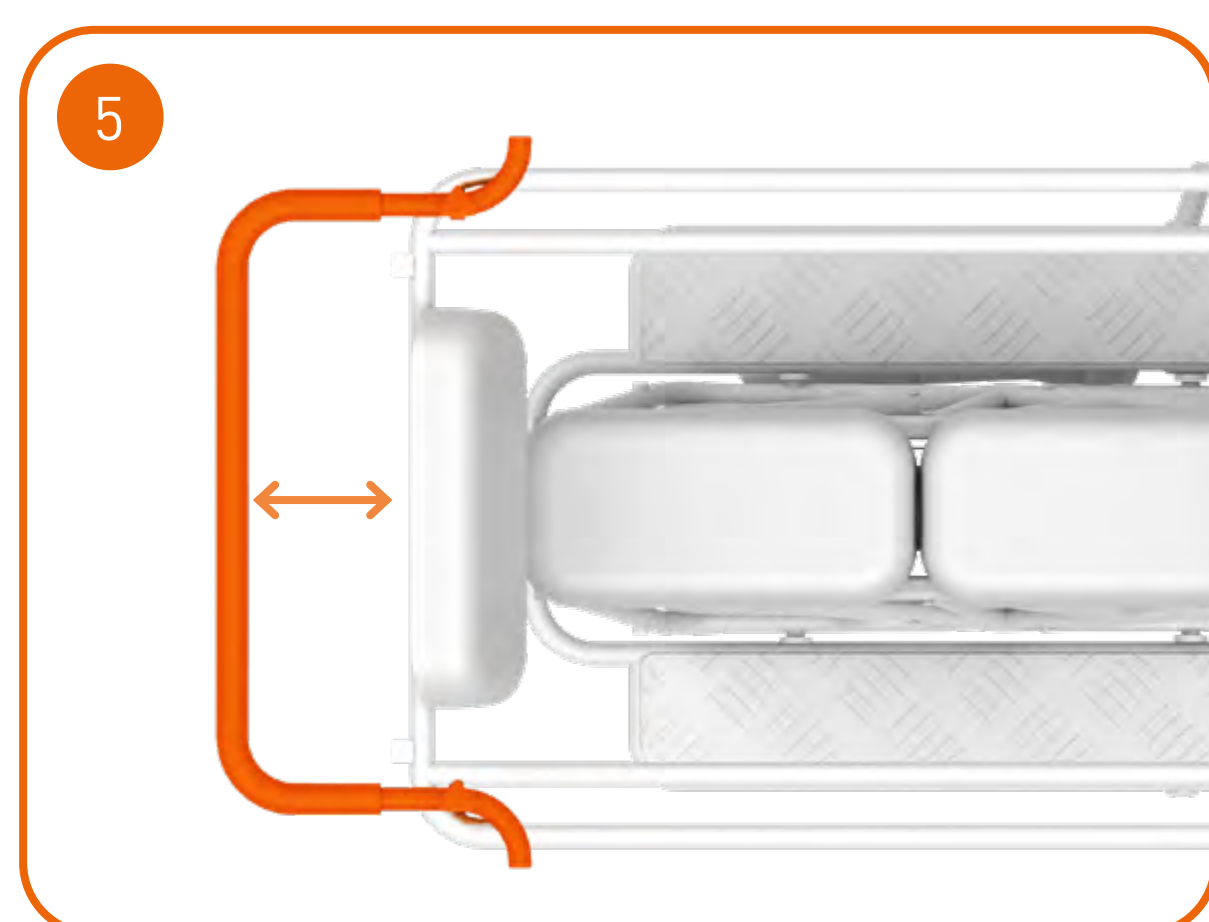
Now hang the children's bike on the hook. Support the BICYCLE HOOK if necessary.
We recommend hooking up the children's bike FIRST and THEN letting the child get on!



Swing the BICYCLE HOOK with the children's bike attached and secure the other side of the BICYCLE HOOK to the Ride Bar. Please note that the clamps are positioned between the outer and inner struts.



Secure the bicycle hook by turning the two knobs clockwise. Ensure that the clamps are pressed down evenly.



You can adjust the space required depending on the width and size of the children's bike. However, make sure that the children's bike is securely and firmly in place.

! Security & Requirements

Please observe the safety instructions and requirements for transporting passengers and loads on the VELO DE VILLE LOADY.
These can be found in the original operating instructions, part 1!

Jiggle the BICYCLE HOOK to check whether it is securely fixed in place. If not, tighten the knobs as described in step 4!



Secure the children's bike particularly well!

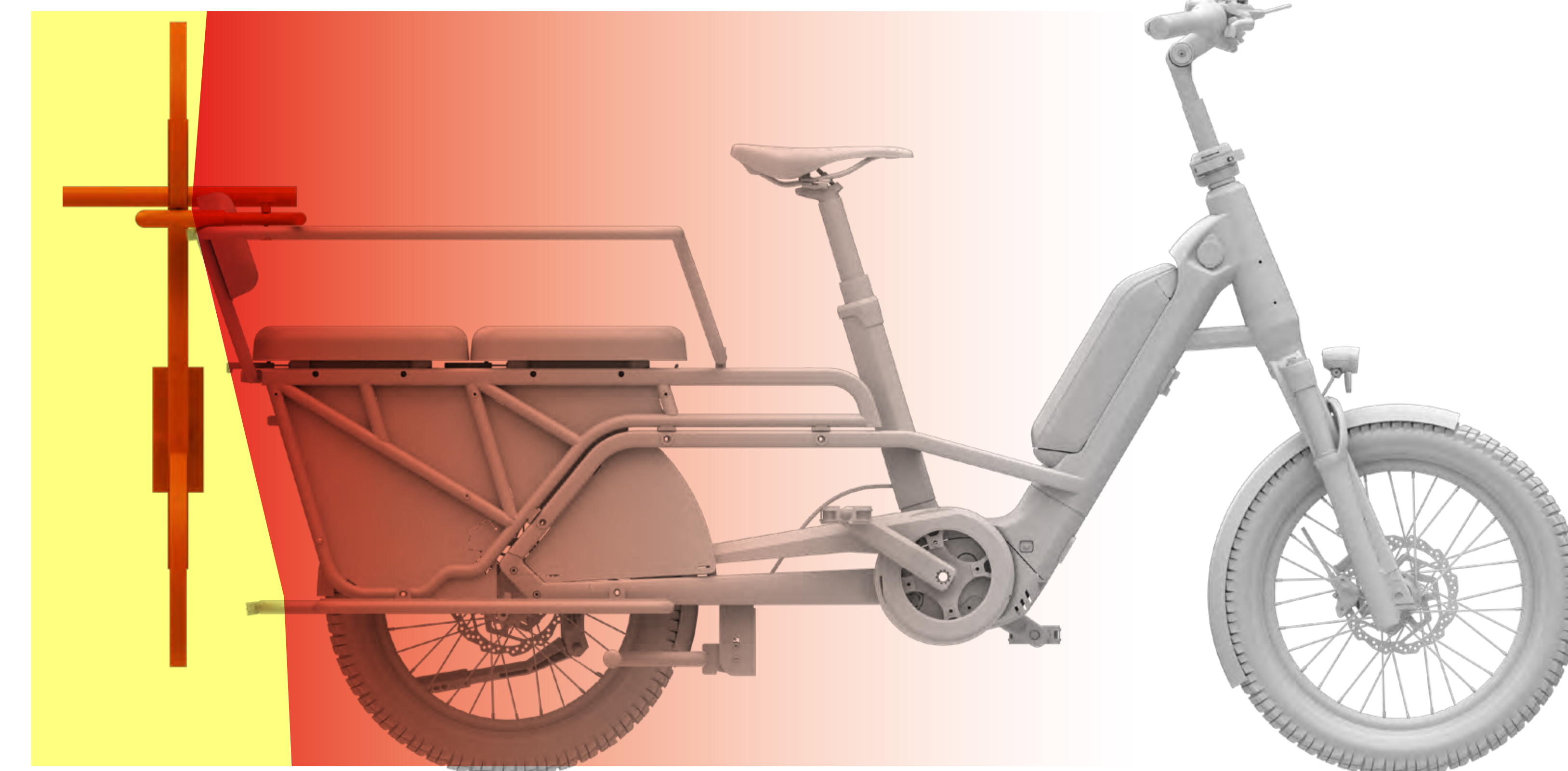
Please ensure and be aware that components of the children's bike may protrude beyond the overall width of the VELO DE VILLE LOADY.

Also ensure that no components of the child's bicycle protrude into the passenger area. There is a risk of injury.

We recommend FIRST attaching the children's bike and THEN letting the child get on, to avoid injuries from bumping into the bike!

Passengers are not permitted to hold onto the BICYCLE HOOK, but only onto the green-marked struts!
